7.0 DISPUTES: Disputes concerning umpire's calls will be between managers and umpire, and such discussion must be handled in a gentlemanly manner. If the umpire is blocked and unable to make a fair and accurate call, then the umpire will confer with the players involved in the play to determine what the call will be and then will make an adjusted call if needed. Consultation may be made with another umpire. Protests about rules must be made to a BOARD MEMBER OR UMPIRE IMMEDIATELY.

8.0 RULE BOOKS: SSUSA Rule books have been issued to all managers, umpires and Board Members to be used as an additional reference for senior softball. The rules listed here will differ somewhat from those found in the rule books because our rules have been developed based on our league's specific needs
