SOME HAVE BEEN USED VERBATIM AND OTHERS HAVE BEEN BEEN MODIFIED TO COMPLY WITH THE LEAGUE PHILOSOPHY OF BEING A RECREATIONAL LEAGUE FOR SENIOR WOMEN AT LEAST 50 YEARS OLD AND SENIOR MEN AT LEAST 60 YEARS OLD DURING THE PLAYING YEAR.
