2020-2021 RULES OF COLLIER COUNTY SUPER 60 SENIOR SOFTBALL

1.0 GAME PLAY:

1.0 (a) PICK- UP GAMES: Begin on November 16 at North Collier Regional Park on Mondays and Wednesdays with batting practice beginning at 8:15 am +/- and play at 9:30 am.

1.0 (b) SEASON: Games on Mondays and Wednesdays, same times as above, starting on January 4 with a practice game and season opener on January 6. Season will end with a single elimination play-off and finished by March 31st.

1.0 (c) TEAMS: A maximum of 8 teams and a maximum of 15 players per team.

1.0 (d) GAMES: Played with maximum 12 players: 5 infielders, 5 outfielders, a pitcher and a catcher. (See rule 1.0 (f) for exceptions of less than 12 players). UMPIRES ARE VOLUNTEERS.

1.0 (e) LINE-UPS: All players in the line-up bat and must play at least 4 innings of a 9 inning game and 3 innings of a 7 inning game (double-header make- up game)

1.0 (f) FORFEIT: Teams must have a minimum of 8 players by 9:30 am or forfeit. If playing with 8 Then the opposing team will provide a catcher. Playing with less than 8 players will be a forfeit. Covid 19 caused shortage will not result in a forfeit.

1.0 (g) LEGAL GAME: A legal game is 4 ½ innings for a 9 inning game and 3 ½ innings for a 7 inning game (double-header make-up game) if home team is ahead.

1.0 (h) TIED GAMES: If a game is tied after regulation play of 7 or 9 innings the TEXAS RULE will go into effect. Each team starts each extra 1/2 inning with the batter who completed his at-bat the previous inning on 2nd base. This runner cannot be PINCH- RUN for until he reaches 3rd base. If this runner cannot run due to an injury, then the next previous batter will be the runner and so on until a player who can run will be found. Players who have exhausted their 3 times to run will be given an extra time to run in the 10th, the 13th inning and each following alternate inning. For a shortened 7 inning game the extra run innings will be the 8th, the 11th etc. until a team wins a completed inning.
